#### **Entries**

- Individual entries are unlimited, though only the top four (4) qualifiers from each school will advance to the finals  $(1^{st} 16^{th})$ 
  - o Bonus Heat (Individual events): The next 8 fastest times will fill the bonus heat.
- Relay entries will be limited to an A and B relay team from each school in prelims. Both relays may swim in the prelims and finals. Teams may enter a C relay (non-scoring) for Prelims and finals if desired. Please notify scoring table if you would like a C relay before leaving from prelims if you are only entering one in Finals.
- No individual shall participate in more than four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which shall be individual events. Being designated as a member of a relay team does not count as an entry until the swimmer actually competes in the event.
  - O Swimmers who are entered in two (2) individual events and two (2) relay events in the prelims, may not drop a relay event from the prelims and move into a different relay for the finals, thus totaling five (5) events.

#### **Diving**

Diving will be conducted according to the 11 Dive Championship format. Please be sure to have your divers in the Hy-Tek team entry. Changes will be allowed up to one (1) hour before the start of the meet. Please email your diving file to Rob Damuth

Every diver will perform five (5) dives, and then the field will be narrowed down to twenty four (24) divers. Those twenty (24) divers will perform three (3) dives and the field will be cut to sixteen (16) divers who will score in Saturday's finals. Divers seventeen (17) through twenty four (24) will dive in exhibition in Saturday's finals. The order of divers will be posted when the divers arrive at the meet on Friday. Each team is required to supply a diving judge for both the prelims and finals.

**Seeding:** 

Seeding into heats for prelims will be done on the basis of times. Remember to indicate seed times for all individual events and relays.

# **Scoring and Awards:**

The Conference Championship meet will be scored to 16

places for individual and to 7 places for relays.

Individual events: 1-8 places is Finals; 9-16 is Consolations; 17-24 is Bonus (non-scoring).

Relays: 1-7 places in Finals; Consolations (B relays); Bonus (C relays) (B & C relays are non-scoring).

The top eight finishers in individual events will receive medals, and the top seven (7) relay teams will receive medals.

A trophy will be awarded to the overall OK Conference Champs, combining the dual meet records with the places in the Conference Meet.

All Conference awards will be determined by taking all first place finishers and the first and second place divers automatically. A third diver will be automatic if he achieves All-American status. The remaining All-Conference positions will be determined by using individual points scored at the meet.

- Championship heat swimmers will be paraded out before each race. The ready area will be in the large storage area at the turn end of the pool.
- Awards will be given out after the final heat of the following event at the blocks.

• The winning coach will hand out the awards.

• The winning preliminary swimmer will choose the parade out music (if appropriate) at the pool deck office Friday.

**Seating:** Athletes: Assigned seating on deck and locker rooms

Spectators: No assigned seating or saving seats

**Tickets:** \$5.00 admissions

\$2.00 heat sheets

**Seniors:** Seniors from each team will be recognized prior to the Finals on

Saturday. Senior presentation will begin at 11:50am.

**Locker Rooms**: There will be no shaving in the locker rooms. Locks will not be allowed overnight,

swimmers may leave them on during each session. Bags of swimmers may be

stored in any of the storage areas once on deck, (see Rob).

**Food on Deck**: NO GLASS! Please limit the food on deck a make sure your area is picked up

when you leave.

**Concessions**: Concessions will be available Friday and Saturday.

<u>Trainer</u>: A certified athletic trainer will be on site throughout the conference meet.
