When students are ready to submit applications, please do the following:

1. Complete application online (if common app, waive rights to read letters of rec and match account with Naviance).
2. Complete blue form to authorize the school to send transcripts/letters of rec (in student support), one week in advance.
3. Send in ACT scores if desired (from [act.org](http://act.org)).

### Juniors and Seniors Should Check Naviance Regularly

Juniors and seniors, please log in to Naviance to sign up for college visits (check this site weekly). There are both virtual and in person meetings coming up. Sign up online 24 hours in advance, and get a pass from the student support office to attend the meeting (in person at the student support offices; virtually, anywhere you can find a quiet space).
