



Beyond Scholastic Journalism Matters

Rationale: Scholastic journalism can open so many doors for careers in both professional journalism and other professional focuses.

Essential Questions:

- For what career opportunities other than journalism can scholastic journalism prepare me?
- How did scholastic journalism experience benefit professionals in various fields today?

Learning Objectives: Students will be able to:

- Develop an understanding of multiple career options that relate to their current work.
- Consider future options pertaining to college major choices and career pathways.
- Understand the importance of the 21st Century Skills scholastic journalism brings to students.

Activity:

- Watch video testimonials.
- View handout or slideshow on possible career pathways.
- Exploring options
 - Adviser breaks students into pairs or small groups.
 - Students list possible careers they would like to pursue in life.
 - Students relate their current scholastic journalism work to those career choices and help each other find connections.
 - Students briefly research one successful professional who worked in scholastic journalism.
- Presentation
 - Students present their findings and career options to the class.
 - Adviser and students discuss opportunities and options for each pathway.

Materials:

- Videos testimonials from former scholastic journalists in the professional realm or working on a degree that isn't directly related to journalism.
