Thank you for your interest in the Summerville-Trion Rotary Scholarship Program. We are proud to say that this program has been in our community for over 85 years, helping students build a brighter future for themselves, their families, and their community. This year you can be a part of it.

The Rotary scholarships will each be \$1,000. These awards will be based on a student's performance with consideration to five aspects of the career: ACT or SAT composite scores, cumulative GPA, financial need, extracurricular activities and office, and work activities.

Please keep this in mind when you turn in your applications to your school counselors by **March 24, 2023**. The applications will be considered and announced within two to three weeks. All recipients must be a resident of Chattooga County to be eligible for a scholarship.
