

Cultural and Leisure activities

1. Introduce the pie charts.

While girls and boys are growing, they are preferring some leisure activities depending on their environment, that include friends, family, neighborhood, and school. There is a hypothesis of also is posible that exist a difference depending if you are boy or girl, so, we going to analysis two charts of data about cultural and leisure activities that prefer boys and girls, where we going to watch all differences and similarities.

2. Write a general overview.

A first glance, we can observe that boys prefer principally computer games while girls show greater inclination towards dancing compared to other activities. Surprisingly! In case the activity of listen to music, both genders have the same percentage of preference. Another significant difference in the results was the preference of reading.

3. Describe the first chart.

The first chart illustrates that boys prefer playing computer games to other activities by 34%. The second most popular leisure with 26% is basketball. Alternatively, soccer plays a role with 17%. Then skateboarding and listening to music are the less activity preferred. In contrast, reading is the least cultural activity that boys participate with two percent.

4. Describe the second chart.

In the second chart, the girls have a similar proportion with the boys, in this case with 11% gymnastics in girls and the same percentage in the skateboarding with the boys. The most popular activity among the girls is dancing with 27%. The netball shows a 15%, while 26% of the boys prefer the basketball. In contrast, reading for boys represents 2%, while for girls is 21%. In comparison, boys and girls prefer listening to music in the same proportion with ten percent.
