Section 1: Instructions for using the Objective Assessment Test Guide during the selection process

For the Test Taker

- For the short scenario, read the scenario and select the best option from the multiple-choice answers provided.
- Answer all questions to the best of your ability.
- There is only one correct answer for each question or scenario.
- Once you have completed the test, review your answers if time permits. Do not leave any question unanswered. If you are unsure, make your best guess.

Instructions for Test Managers:

- Provide a copy of the objective selection test to each test taker.
- Clearly communicate the instructions and ensure that the test takers understand the format of the test.
- Inform the test takers about the time limit for the test, if applicable.
- Remind the test takers to answer all the questions and not to leave any question unanswered.
- Monitor the test-taking process to ensure fairness and prevent any misconduct.
- Once the test is completed, collect the answer sheets or test papers from the test takers.
