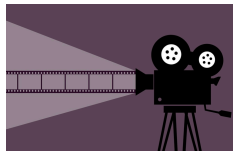


Make Social Media For and Against Prohibition

Create a social media campaign to promote adding a woman, Native American, or Black American of your choosing to U.S. currency.



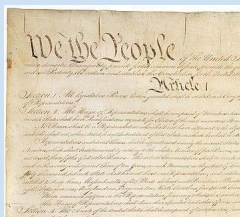
Compare and Contrast Politicians' Use of Twitter Regarding the Equality Act

Design a social media campaign to build support for the inclusion of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) in the Constitution.



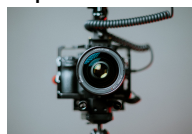
Design a Format for Future Supreme Court TV Coverage
