Position Announcement:

Job Responsibilities/Role:

General tasks: Lead programs and events, return telephone calls, respond to emails, update social media sites, assist with programs and events, troubleshoot and problem solve when challenges arise, perform outreach efforts about the CRCs and our programs and other duties:

- Required to check in weekly with updates on tasks assigned
- Required to complete 5 hours of paid Professional Development per term by the end of the school year
- Required to attend quarterly CRC trainings and summer orientation

Qualifications:

A successful candidate will be a **reliable**, **detail oriented**, **independent worker** who has the ability to **multitask**, **communicate** effectively, and provide **excellent customer service**.

- Knowledge of Microsoft Office and the Google Suite
- Knowledge of PSU's student services and resources
- Demonstrated or be in the process of gaining knowledge of and sensitivity to traditionally underrepresented students (including, but not limited to, Asian/Pacific Islander, Asian-American, African, African-American, Chicana, Hispanic, Native American, Alaskan Native, Middle Eastern, North African, South Asian, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, and Questioning students)
- Minimum undergraduate 2.5 cumulative GPA and completion of 6 undergraduate credits each quarter while employed
- Minimum graduate 3.0 cumulative GPA and completion of 5 graduate credits each quarter while employed
- Must be in good academic standing for the term prior to selection and during the entire period of employment.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Familiarity with the cultures and traditions of the specific program (ie: Latinx communities when working with La Casa Latina Student Center)
- Knowledge and understanding of diverse communities at PSU and in the Portland Metro area
- Familiarity with the center and the students and PSU community that utilize it
