MISS CULPEPER RODEO – OFFICIAL CONTRACT

(Rules, Guidelines, Exhibits A & B)

STATUS & AUTHORITY

By signing this Contract, the undersigned accepts the position of Miss Culpeper Rodeo. CRC shall be the sponsoring organization. The Pageant Director designated by CRC shall serve as direct supervisor. This role is governed as an independent contractor relationship.

CONDUCT

Miss Culpeper Rodeo shall uphold the highest moral, ethical, and professional standards. Prohibited conduct includes smoking, vaping, alcohol misuse, illegal drugs, inappropriate language, public intoxication, inappropriate social behavior, or conduct detrimental to CRC.

RELATIONSHIP & PERSONAL STATUS

During the reign, Miss Culpeper Rodeo shall not marry, become engaged, cohabitate in an intimate relationship, or become pregnant. Violation may result in immediate forfeiture of title.

SOCIAL MEDIA

All social media must reflect western values and CRC standards. CRC reserves authority to require removal of content.

APPEARANCES & TRAVEL

All appearances must be approved. CRC may provide lodging or host homes. Travel expenses shall follow CRC policies.

SPONSORSHIP & FINANCIAL HANDLING

All sponsorship funds raised under the title shall be approved by CRC. Funds requiring receipts must be processed through CRC accounts. Reimbursements require receipts.



CORONATION & FUNDRAISING

Net proceeds from coronation events shall be handled per CRC direction and reported with full accounting.

WARDROBE & CHAPS

Wardrobe and chaps must align with CRC branding. CRC-owned items remain CRC property.

MEDIA RELEASE & IMAGE RIGHTS

Miss Culpeper Rodeo grants CRC irrevocable rights to use name, image, likeness, voice, and appearance for promotional, marketing, and archival purposes without compensation.

REMOVAL & FORFEITURE

CRC may remove the title for violation of this Contract. Upon removal, all crowns, sashes, apparel, titles, prizes, and future use of the title shall be immediately forfeited.

ARBITRATION

All disputes shall be resolved by binding arbitration under the Virginia Uniform Arbitration Act.

INDEMNIFICATION

Miss Culpeper Rodeo agrees to indemnify and hold harmless CRC from claims arising from misconduct or breach.

GOVERNING LAW

Commonwealth of Virginia.

EXHIBIT A – ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be between 19–26 years of age as of January 1 of the contract year.
- Must reside in Culpeper & surrounding counties to be approved by CRC.
- Must be unmarried, not pregnant, and without dependents.
- Must be of good moral character.



- Must be legally eligible to work in the U.S.
- No conflicting contracts.

Must be available June 6 & 7 Also September 4, 5 & 6 of 2026

- 2nd Offense: Probation / Board Review
- 3rd Offense: Probation Extension or Removal
- Repeat: Immediate Removal and Forfeiture
