- Liaise with Head(s) of Photography and cartoonists to ensure a visually appealing lifestyle section of the paper
- Arrange any interviews and features possible which are relevant to the section:
- Liaise with the Carolynne Online Editor(s) to ensure range of relevant content for section is available to publish online
- Ensure the relevance of section to students by identifying current student social interests and activities

Applicants should demonstrate that they are lively, imaginative and confident in leading a team. They should have an eye for spotting things that would be of interest to the readers of SCAN, that are entertaining and that add something to their student experience. They should also be able to provide a good balance between light-hearted and serious issues.

Experience in SCAN is desirable but applications will be considered from applicants with other relevant experience. Candidates with no previous experience in SCAN should not be dissuaded from applying; applications are welcomed and encouraged from everyone wishing to contribute to and learn about the paper.
