

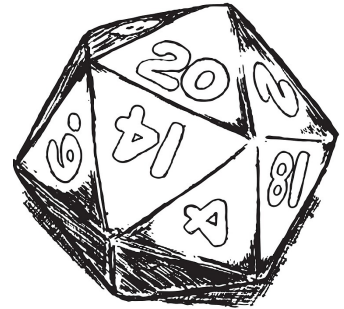


TABLE-TOP ROLEPLAYING GAME CLUB
