Times

The best times to visit are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 12:45 - 1:10 pm (lunchtime visit) or 1:40 - 2:30 pm (class visit).

Wednesday afternoons from 1:15 pm - 2:30 pm are good times for visits that involve large groups or minifair sessions.

VSA is about 15-minute walk away from MTR Wong Chuk Hang Station Exit B. When it is hot we recommend that you take a taxi.

There is a public transport terminus about a 5-minutes walk from the Campus with the following buses and minibuses:

- Citybus No. 48 from Wah Fu (North) to Shum Wan
- Citybus No. 72A from Causeway Bay to Shum Wan
- Citybus No. 75 from Exchange Square to Shum Wan
- Citybus No. 97A from Lei Tung Estate to Shum Wan

- Minibus No. 29 from Ap Lei Chau to Shum Wan
- Minibus No. 59A from Aberdeen (Tung Sing Road) to Shum Wan
