What We're Learning



ELA: What Inspires poets to write poetry?

Students will be working toward becoming experts about a chosen poet. They will be researching their poet independently, as well as, with a small group. They will use their research to cite evidence from the poet's poetry to describe what inspired their poet to write his or her poems.



Math: Use Place Value Strategies to Add and Subtract Whole Number

Students will begin learning about place value strategies. During this unit students will explain that in a multi-digit number, a digit in one place represents 10 times as much as it represent in the place to its right, up to 100,000, read and write multi-digit numbers up to and including 100,000 using numerals, number names, and expanded form, and compare two multi-digit numbers up to and including 100,000 based on the values of the digits in each place, using $>$, $=$, $<$ symbols to record the results of the comparisons.



Science: Forms and Interactions of Energy

This week we will continue working with various forms of energy. Students will recognize that energy takes various forms that may be grouped based on their interaction with matter.
