Praying the word

Authentic Prayer

When I Pray Help Me to...

- 1. Be Honest, <u>Transparent</u>, Authentic (Ps. 13:1-4)
 - I wrestle with Anxiety. What do you wrestle with?
 - Get in touch with your **feelings**. David did.
 - My enemy is out to <u>kill me</u>.

John 10:10 "The thief comes only to steal and **kill** and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full.

- David had a <u>sickness</u> "Give light to my eyes or I will sleep in death
- 2. Always Include a "BUT I Trust in Your Unfailing Love" (Ps. 13:5)
 - Speak out your trust in Jesus
 - Zero in on His <u>Unfailing Love</u>
 - Listen for **God's Voice** (Prov. 3:5-6)
- 3. Always Include **Praise**
 - My heart is <u>filled with joy</u> under every <u>circumstance</u>.
 - Sing a song in Your heart to the Lord
