

Michigan's 2020- 21 Return to School Roadmap

PHASE 5

CLEANING

STRONGLY RECOMMENDED

1. Frequently touched surfaces including lights, doors, benches, and bathrooms should undergo cleaning at least every four hours with either an EPA approved disinfectant or diluted bleach solution. **Very difficult to achieve with current staff in the building during the day. Most of this gets done during the evening prior to the start of school. Additional staff will be required to perform these tasks**
2. Libraries, computer labs, arts, and other hands-on classrooms should undergo cleaning after every class period with either an EPA-approved disinfectant or diluted bleach solution. Efforts must be made to minimize sharing of materials between students, as able. **– This won't be achievable without the help of the staff and students.**
3. Student desks should be wiped down with either an EPA-approved disinfectant or diluted bleach solution after every class period. **– This won't be achievable without the help of the staff and students.**
4. Playground structures should continue to undergo normal routine cleaning, but using an EPA approved disinfectant is unnecessary.
5. Athletic equipment can be cleaned with either an EPA-approved disinfectant or diluted bleach solution before and after each use. **– This task is achievable.**
6. Ensure safe and correct use and storage of cleaning and disinfection products, including storing products securely away from children, and with adequate ventilation when staff use such products. **– Already doing**
7. **Bid out 9 additional Clorox 360 electrostatic sprayers. One for each building.**

RECOMMENDED

Staff should wear gloves, surgical masks, and faceshield when performing all cleaning activities. **Already doing**
