**OLD BUSINESS:**

- Lyon Mountain Wastewater Treatment Plant upgrades – There was a meeting yesterday and Supervisor Varin feels that there should be a punch list added to the project, several poorly executed repairs have left some damage, and these should be fixed, the water district is paying a lot to have these upgrades completed by professionals and it should look professional. Still waiting on parts that have been backordered.
- Books closeout started – January date is set to close out the 2025 books.
- Phone system upgrade – the newer phones are here just waiting for Verizon to reach out and have them installed.
- NCC Fire alarm notification system – NCC came on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and they fixed the issue that has been contacting Councilman Carter at 2am every night.
- Grates for sewer station in district 2 – the grates are rusted in district, Highway Superintendent stated there are grates up in the cold storage just need to get them out and see if they will work, if not new ones will need to be ordered.
- Pheonix Trailings – the company is very interested in doing some mining for a certain mineral in the ore sand, they will extract the mineral and leave the remaining sand. They are planning on coming soon.
- Gordan Road – Supervisor Varin stated that the town owns the Gordan Road off from Wilfred King Road and would like to clarify that the Town is only interested in the road not the private property that surrounds it. Sherwood Dubrey came in to speak to the Board about the comments that were made last month about him, he wants everyone to know that he is not responsible for the removal of the signs and spoke to the new owner of the property down there very nicely and cordially. He also would like to explain that there is a town road, but it stops at his property. Supervisor Varin explained again that he is just interested in the town road issue not the private property issue.
- Councilman Tolosky is inquiring about the company Brookfield who was interested in the town property for the battery storage. Supervisor Varin said that there was an email from them that asked when they can come and discuss the next steps. Councilman Tolosky also wanted to know if we know the mineral that Pheonix Trailings wanted, Supervisor Varin stated he had no idea yet, but when he knows he will let everyone know more about it. Also, the Board discussed having a survey done at the sand pit would help determine the quantity of sand that is left.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- Grant search for Chazy Lake Dam repair – the town has asked Liz Tedford to look for more grants concerning the repairs on the dam, repairs are needed regardless but some financial help would be nice.
- Comprehensive plan – the Town needs to get moving forward on this, the town needs help with the applications process and will hire Jaclyn Hanes from MJ Engineering to assist moving forward.
- Councilman Carter stated he needs to still contact Kelly from Emergency Services about the issue on Tamarack Lane with the 911.

Supervisor Varin – Dog report is in, nothing more.

Councilman Barber – Home on 978 State Route 374 that burned down is having water in the basement, it is not coming from the curb stop, needs to have basement pumped and figure out what is going on down there.

William Gurbal, District 2 operator, is retiring and has rendered his resignation for the position to be effective in March or April of 2026.
