## "Chores" Animation

## Project - Create a pivot animation of you doing chores

## **Project Goals**

- 1. Create a background of a location chores would take place and import it into Pivot Animator
- 2. Animate your stick-figures to convincingly illustrate a scene of a parent/adult and child interacting over chores on your background in 360 frames at 12 fps
  - a. Add speech bubbles and/or thought bubbles to provide dialogue
- 3. Save your animation as a .GIF when you are done & embed in your portfolio

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Create a BACKGROUND You must create a situation in which chores get done (the setting can be a kitchen, bedroom, yard, etc.) in **PAINT** and import it into the first frame of your movie. Save it as a .png WIDTH should be <= 1200 pixels x 600 high.
- 2. Create ACTION Add frames and dialogue between a parent/adult and a child to make your stick-figure(s) act out the scene on your background. Your animation MUST:
  - include enough detail to make the scene believable and recognizable
  - include movement and dialogue of both characters
- 3. Required TIME Your animation must be a minimum of 30 seconds long.

At the default rate of 12 fps, how many frames must your animation have to be 30 seconds long? **360** frames

- 4. EXPORT ANIMATION When your movie is done:
  - 1. Go to FILE
  - 2. Choose EXPORT ANIMATION
  - 3. Choose ANIMATED GIF
  - 4. Navigate to your **Chores** folder, name your file **Chores**, click Save
  - 5. Set height to be 600 pixel and make sure Loop is checked, click Export



In order to create a speech bubble or thought bubble use **PIVOT** or **PAINT**. *IF USING PAINT*, start by creating a thought bubble or callout, then insert a text box. Next type what you want to be said. Finally reduce the size of the "page" to be as small as possible and save as a .png (name it very carefully as you may need a lot of these to complete your scene)
