As a reader, We have always liked articles with fewer words. But, we somehow cannot make it happen when we write.

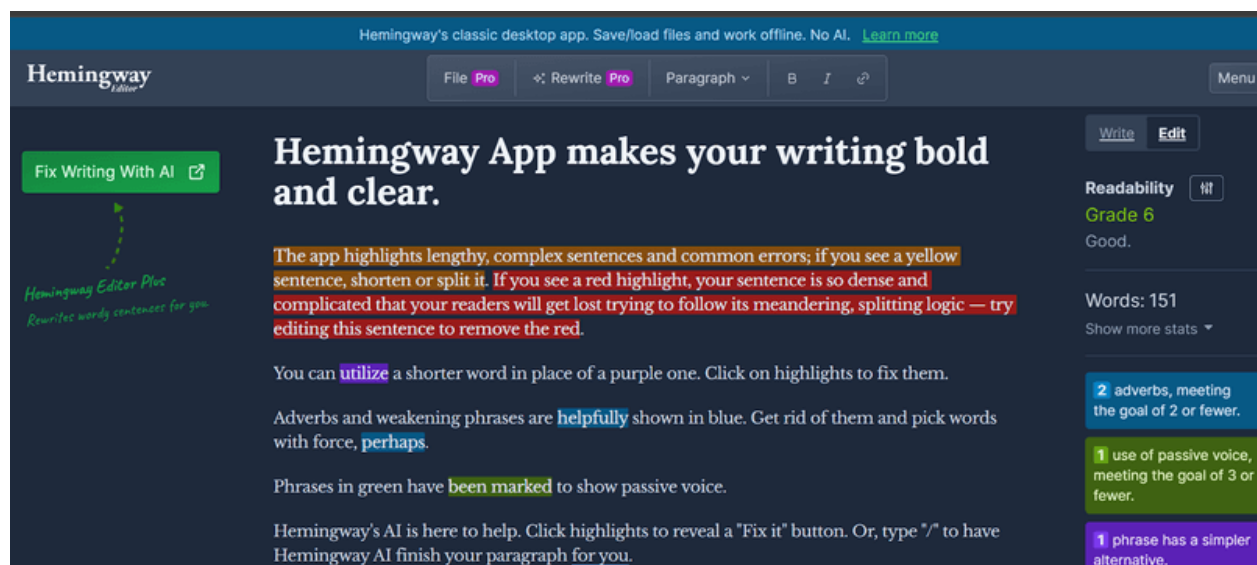
Well, that's where the [Hemingway](#) app comes in.

- Option to import and export files to edit.

Pros of the Hemingway App

It's useful for both new and experienced writers. It makes your writing resonate with your audience.

We found the colour-coding feature pretty useful in the long run. It highlights your sentences to make sure you know how you sound to the readers.

- Blue for too many adverbs. 12 or less is the goal.
- Green is for passive voice. The goal is to have no passive voices.
- Purple is for phrases. 0 phrases is the goal.
- Orange marks hard-to-read sentences for readability.
- Red is for very hard-to-read sentences that make your text sound complex.

The best thing about this is it tells you the grade level you sound to the readers. If you want a bigger audience (or you don't want to sound too technical) you can adjust your writing like that.

Cons of Hemingway App

Let's talk about what's lacking in Hemingway.

Though it helps in sentence structure and effective writing, it lacks one main thing.

Style.

Shortening your text and making it simple, can stop you from having a style or a voice that your audience resonates with. Also, writing that sounds too simple in bits and pieces might not be ideal in every situation as in some cases, you may miss the flow or the writing may sound lifeless to the readers.

Correcting grammar also needs credits and even after the credits it is still not as good as Grammarly for correcting grammar.

It will still charge you for words whether you use the AI correction or not which was a bit disappointing to use and other than this, we found no other cons.

Compared to other popular writing assistants, Hemingway stood out, and here's the difference between free and paid plans:

- Only web access and no desktop version.
- Importing and exporting files (.docx, .html, .md formats only).
- Readability score and colour coding feature.
- Basic writing feedback like adverbs, passive voice, etc...
- 14-day free trial for up to 200 AI sentence corrections in the free plan.

PAID PLAN MONTHLY

- 5000-10000 AI sentences on a \$10 - \$15 monthly plan.
- Fixes the tone, grammar, and length of your content.
- Ability to use the Dark mode.
- Choose and adjust your audience's reading level.
- Extra credits if you are using it as a team or a business organization.

PAID DESKTOP APP

- One-time deal of \$19.99 (without taxes) for Mac and Windows.
- Works without internet.
- No AI features.
- One-click integration with WordPress and Medium.
- Export as text, PDF, Word, HTML, or markdown.
- Ability to highlight the improvements of your content and share it with others.

Final Verdict

Hemingway Editor is a good tool for those who want their writing to sound easy, clear, and simple for readers. We would rate it 8.5 out of 10 especially because it provides good features in both free and PRO plan and improves the overall quality of the content.
