CRCKY LEGAL PROGRAM

What kind of help can I get from this program?

Help completing immigration forms for asylum, change of address forms for USCIS, FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) requests, and requests/renewals for work permits (Employment Authorization Documents, also called EADS).

What does it cost?

Services are free but spaces are limited.

Who can get help?

For asylum: New immigrants who have been in the U.S. for less than a year and want to apply for asylum or eligible immigrants with expiring/expired immigration statuses that want to apply for asylum.

For employment authorization: Immigrants who need help submitting their request/renewal for employment authorization.

For FOIAs and Change of Address: Any immigrant who needs legal assistance with immigration related issues and whose case is not currently in immigration court

Will I qualify?

Only a limited number of clients will be accepted. You must be eligible to file an asylum petition under current law and CRCKY will determine whether you can participate in the program. You will be notified within two weeks of your request whether you have been accepted into the program.

What is CRCKY?
