Treasurers' Report

Amy - believes we approved certain items that were not added to the budget.

Remaining balance \$36,000 after allocations.

Julie - another allocation on October 8th is inbound from Magic Hat. Sylvia will go to the meeting this week and get the check.

Amy/Julie - Discussion that how the hours are paid out will be adjusted so that funds are distributed more equitably if there are big discrepancies between PCOs..

\$3500 from parent contributions, typically around \$10,000; have another \$1,000 coming in and Julie said she had another one.

Funding Requests

- Budget increase for Teacher/Staff Professional Development as we have been getting sporadic requests. With an allocated budget, we will not have to call a meeting in order to get approvals.
- Currently \$2500 allocated, Julie recommending we go to \$10,000 as a result of the surplus.
- Julie does not believe Magic Hat will be willing to pay for these, however, Sylvia indicates we should make the case that ultimately pro dev benefits the children. However, we isolate the decision to this year and make sure that staffing is adequate.
- All in favor of increasing the budget.
