



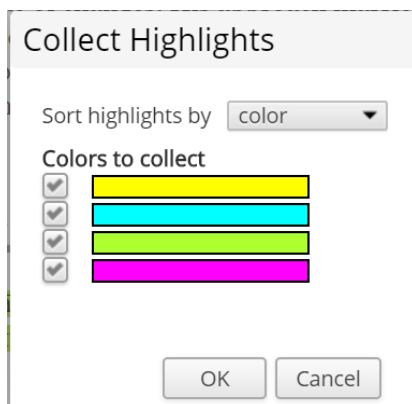
Learning how to use highlights in Read and Write for Google Chrome

1. Providing students with targeted questions, will allow them to color code their responses as they read. Encourage them to choose one color for each question and the colors to assign the answers. For our activity, these are the three targeted questions:
 - a. Pink - What are the experiments by Dr. Brandon Barton that are described in the article? Choose one experiment that you find particularly interesting and consider the effects it has on society.
 - b. Yellow - Why does Dr. Barton do the work that he does?
 - c. Green - What line(s) really got you thinking?



2. If you decide you don't want something, choose the broom and click on what you want to get rid of.
3. When you are done with your assignment, click on the colorful "recycle" sign. This again, may ask for permissions to access your Drive. Allow, as it is again sending a file with your notes to Drive.
4. You will also get a popup window to ask what colors you want to collect and how you want to collect them. At this time, you could choose to get rid of the vocab highlights, or keep them.

6. Labeling and responding - Encourage them to copy and paste the questions above the color coding. Then, you can ask them to also respond after each section with comments and thoughts.
7. Again, good habits, rename the file "Ladybug Questions", go to Google Drive and move the file into your grade level and subject folder.
