



Our school has a subscription to **Swank**, a K-12 movie streaming service that allows you to show licensed movies to your classes to support your curriculum.

The portal URL is: <https://digitalcampus.swankmp.net/tjms406752>

You can also get to this link by going to the "Library" tab on the school's website, then "For Faculty" and "Swank."

Your initial instructor login credentials:

Username: your first initial + last name, all lowercase

Password: Welcome12345

If you do not know your current password or the generic password does not work, please email me at tcollins@fairlawnschools.org so I can reset it. You will get an email from Swank instructing you to change your password.

****Do not change your username, only your password.****

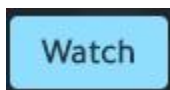
Searching for Films and Requesting Films

You can search for titles through their search feature. To request access to a film that is not currently licensed, click on "Title Request" and complete the form. You **must** fill out the "rationale" part, but it doesn't have to be long: a 1-2 sentence explanation of how this film will be used to support your curriculum will suffice.

Note: There is a two-step process for requesting titles that aren't included in our subscription currently, but there is a limit to the number of films that can be added, so not all requests will be approved.

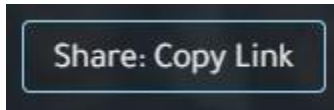
Watching Films

When you find a movie you want to show to your class, you can choose to either "Watch" (show a film to your class) or "Share" (send a link to students so they can watch on their own).



If you click "Watch", the film will play.

Sharing Films with Students



If you want to share the film with your students to watch on their own (or for students who were absent to be able to make up), select "Share: Copy Link", which gives you a link that can be shared through Google Classroom for students to watch outside of your class time.

Student Login

There is a generic login for students (see below). If you share a film link with students (i.e., post the link in Google Classroom), then they will need to log in so they can watch the movie:

Username: TJMStudent

Password: Students2025

Note: these credentials are case sensitive, so remind students to type carefully!

Students may not copy and paste these credentials they will not be able to sign in.

One Final Note: Although Swank provides access to full-length films, consider showing only clips or selected scenes, whenever possible. Swank doesn't have a mechanism for assigning or showing just a clip, but you can tell students, "watch from 7:00-15:00", etc.
