Dear University of Minnesota Morris community and future students,

At the Board of Regents meeting on October 13, 2022, Vice Chair and Regent Steve Sviggum asked if the Morris campus of the University of Minnesota has "become too diverse for, you know, for—for a student to attend." He cited two friends whose children "just didn't feel comfortable" choosing Morris for their college education.

As faculty and staff who have the honor to work at UMN Morris, we consider this what we might call in the classroom "a teaching moment." During the media coverage that has followed this exchange, Regent Sviggum argued that no question is unreasonable or offensive to ask about university policy. On October 18, he issued an apology; we still see value in asserting our support for diversity & inclusion at Morris and walking through the erroneous premise of this question:

- It is grounded in an unstated, yet no less real, fear of racial & ethnic diversity generally and people of color specifically.
- By connecting enrollment issues to demographics, Regent Sviggum is inaccurately faulting students of color rather than addressing the well-documented marginalization and inequities these students face.
- Regent Sviggum knows that the significant Native American student community at
   Morris has grown in part from the <u>tuition waiver</u> for qualified Native students, rooted in
   state & federal statutes that result from the history of the campus space as a Native
   American boarding school. He is also aware of the University's aim of <u>global competence</u>
   that is supported through encouraging a diverse student population.
- Who exactly is the prospective student Regent Sviggum was describing? Why would it
  ever be a bad thing for white students to attend college alongside BIPOC students?
  Indeed, the question is offensive to the many white students who understand the value of
  studying at a racially diverse campus.

Rather than dwelling on this moment, however, we want to emphasize the many good things that are happening around diversity at the University of Minnesota Morris. Faculty, staff, and students are involved in a variety of efforts that highlight our commitment to inclusion and make us proud to learn and work here:

- Community engagement projects at the Center for Small Towns
- An astonishing variety of <u>student organizations</u> that work toward a full calendar of creative and mutually supportive activities related to the diverse lives of Morris students, including events like the annual Powwow, Taste of Asia, and the Drag Show

- <u>Discussions</u> and <u>training</u> to build a more equitable and inclusive campus environment so that students feel a sense of belonging and so that while students' ideas might conflict, they themselves do not have to be in conflict
- As a Native American-Serving Nontribal Institution, the part we play in a critically needed <u>federal program</u>; the <u>Native American Student Success</u> program supports students for whom higher education has not typically been welcoming or accessible
- <u>Equity</u>, <u>Diversity</u>, <u>& Intercultural Programs</u>—housed in the only building remaining on our nationally-registered historic campus from the era of the Indian boarding schools—which makes a home on campus for students to live as their full selves through an array of events and resources including lectures, discussions, a clothes closet, and food provisions
- The simple fact that diversity in many forms (not just race) makes Morris an exceptional learning environment—for some students, UMN Morris is the most diverse place they have encountered, while for others, this is the least diverse. (Some <u>oral history projects</u> housed in the UMN Morris Archives attest to how diversity adds value to our research and teaching.)
- Memorialization of the campus's fraught history through building symbolic, physical, and educational spaces for remembrance and inclusion. (One of the most visible examples is the <u>Nokoomis Nibii Equay</u> sculpture.)

To our students of color and other marginalized groups: we want you to know that your teachers and supporters at UMN Morris are paying attention. Although we know there is still more work needed to advance equity, we care about your wellbeing as well as your irreplaceable contributions to this community. To everyone reading this letter, including potential Morris students of the future: we hope you'll join us on the prairie for exciting opportunities to learn and grow together in what we hope will be an ever more diverse and inclusive environment.
