This year, as in the past, we will be emphasizing a consistent approach to personal organization for learning. **Please be aware that some teachers may require additional materials for their subject. Students will be notified of these additions during the first week of school.**

ALL STUDENTS

Personal Supplies:

- 3-ring binder (3 inch rings)
- Wide ruled loose-leaf notebook paper
- 1 set 8 subject dividers
- (1) two-pocket folder for Health class *(if we require a binder, then we won't need the folder - if we don't require a binder, then I would like to keep the folder)*
- pencil pouch with three holes
- Pens
- Multipack highlighters
- **Wired** earbuds or headphones for Chromebooks
- Ti-34 Multiview calculators will be available for use during the school year.
- Pencils

Physical Education Uniform: It is highly recommended that all students have a change of clothing for physical education class. **Closed toe shoes are required for PE. *Purchase of the uniform is optional.*** Students may wear their own clothing for PE (blue or gray shorts, white or gray t-shirt with no logos, sweatshirt and sweatpants for cold weather). Please make sure that your child's uniform is marked with his/her name.

PE uniforms can be ordered directly from the company selling shirts at the start of the school year. Please see your physical education teacher for additional information.

Other Recommended Supplies:

Students are encouraged to bring their own personal calculator (labeled with name). However, one will be supplied as necessary. Please wait to see what your math teacher suggests.

Students taking Algebra or higher are encouraged to purchase their own graphing calculator. If a student cannot purchase a calculator, one will be loaned to the student for the duration of the course. Any damage to or loss of the loaned calculator will result in a financial obligation.
