

General Information

- August 24th is the first official day of school for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Students will be using Canvas as the learning management system to complete course work for the 2020-2021 school year.
- All students will have courses loaded into their Canvas accounts by August 24th.
- Teachers will load material into the Canvas platform one week at a time.
- Student assignments for the previous week are due each Sunday by 10:00 PM (unless otherwise indicated by the classroom teacher). The first week of assignments are due by 10:00 PM on August 30, 2020.

Preparing Your Device

If you have internet at home:

- connect your device to the internet using your current wifi.
- navigate to:
<https://lunenburgcountyschools.instructure.com>
- login with your school email credentials.
- from your Canvas dashboard chose the course in which you want to work on
- complete all necessary assignments.

If you do not have an internet connection at home:

- Each school and the school board office parking lot has internet access. You may access the internet by parking near the school building and using your credentials to bypass the filter.
- Once connected to the internet navigate to:

- From your Canvas dashboard choose the course in which you want to work on
