How do I buy a dog? What are dog slots?

Answer: Go to Earthly Goods>Foundation Auctions. Each foundation dog is up for auction for six (6) hours and bids may be placed on the dog at this time. The new auctions are created with a random breed at four (4) and ten (10) Ala time every day based off of Alacrity time. These dogs are titled as foundation, meaning they have no parents and have no lineage on Alacrity. These will help start your own line of dogs.

OR

Find a dog that is being sold by another member of Alacrity. To do this you can go to Life>Search: use the dog search box and select "for sale" and the specific breed you are looking for. You can also go to Earthly Goods>Auctions>Dog Auctions instead.

OR

There are always the Pound dogs looking for homes! If you would like a Pound dog go to Life>The Pound. These dogs have been placed there by either the owner's choice, the dog ran away and were not claimed, or they were not bought through the foundation auctions. These dogs are **fixed** (neutered or spayed) and cost \$500. This means they cannot be bred but they can still be trained and trailed like all dogs on Alacrity.

OR

If you cannot get a dog you like from the previous options there is another option. You can create your own dog by using the Custom Tool (listed under Help Alacrity). This method cost a minimum of eight (8) bones and a maximum of eight-teen (18) depending on the number of

markings you choose. When new breeds are released they will be available in the Custom Tool first for two (2) weeks before they are placed in foundation auctions.

What are dog slots? What are Kennels?

The Basics

Kennel slots are basically the capacity of which your kennel can hold. When starting out on Alacrity you have five (5) kennel slots but you can purchase more on the *My Kennels* page or the *Bone Exchange* page. You can only have the same amount of dogs in your kennel as the number of slots you have. However, if a dog is under two (2) months of age it shares a kennel slot with over puppies of that age. If a dog is older than two (2) months they have their own slot. Once the puppies reach two months of age, if you have not purchased more slots to hold them in they will force out a random dog in your kennel and it will 'run away' to the pound.

Separate Kennels on the *My Kennels* page can have any number of dogs within each as long as it is within the number of slots you have. It is just a way to divide up your main kennel. You can create them by clicking the *Manage My Kennels* link at the top of the kennels page.

All In

Kennel slots are basically the capacity of which your kennel can hold. You can only have the same amount of dogs in your kennel as the number of slots you have. Although, if a dog is under two (2) months of age it shares a kennel slot with over puppies of that age. If a dog is older than two (2) months they have their own slot. Once the puppies reach two (2) months of age and you have not purchased more slots to hold them in they will force out a random dog in your kennel and it will 'run away' to the pound. When starting out on Alacrity you have five (5) kennel slots but you can purchase more on the *My Kennels* page or the *Bone Exchange* page. Each basic account has the ability to purchase up to 10 **more** dog slots with Alacrity cash, for a total of 15 slots, or 15 dogs. When purchasing slots with Alacrity cash the amount it takes to purchase them will increase by \$2,000 per slot, starting at \$5,000. (ex: 5k, 7k, 9k). After 15 slots, all slots purchases must be done with bones or through the purchase of an upgrade (please remember not all upgrades come with kennel slots). Purchasing a 2 month upgrade will give you 1 additional slot, plus the ability to buy 1 more with Alacrity cash. Purchasing a year upgrade will give you 3 additional slots, plus the ability to buy 3 more with Alacrity cash. Finally, by purchasing a custom made dog by using the Custom Tool you will receive 1 dog slot.

Separate Kennels on the *My Kennel* page can have any number of dogs in each kennel as long as it is within the number of slots you have. It is a way to divide up your main kennel if you have many dogs and want sections for trialing dogs, customs, puppies and so on. You can create them by clicking the *Manage My Kennels* link at the top of the my kennel page. Once on that page you can make 2 kennels (for basic accounts) and 5 kennels (for upgrades) for \$2,000 each. Any further kennels will need to be purchased on the bone exchange page. To remove a kennel it will cost \$750. You can place the dogs in each kennel on the *Manage My Kennels* page where you can also feed individual kennels as well as vaccinate.

How do I feed and care for my dog? Must finish

Basics

First you are going to need some food! Go to Earthly Goods>Main Stores. Here you will see a variety of stores to buy site items like toys, food, backgrounds, grooming items and more. You will need to choose Gnashers to find the food. Once you have purchased food you can go to your Inventory page (under Earthly Goods), click on the food, and select the dog you would like to feed it to. You do not have to feed your dog every day, just watch their hunger levels. If their hunger is at 0/10 is isn't hungry. If their hunger is at 8/10 they will be very hungry. If they reach 8/10 you should feed them. (Maybe mention again about feeding dogs through the Manage My Kennels page and that upgraded members have a feed all button.)

Each item increases/decreases different stats by different amounts, but here's a good rule of thumb:

Health: Can be increased by feeding, grooming, vaccinations, companions and the refill at 12:00am server time.

Mood/happiness: Can be increased by toys, grooming, companions, accessories and breeding.

Energy: Can be increased by grooming, feeding, companions and the refill at 12:00am server time.

If your dog does not appear in the drop down ('actions') part of your inventory, they do not need the item.

All In

must be under 100 and grooming limit up to 3 times daily

How do I change a dog's scene?

Answer: You can decorate a dog's scene after you have purchased the items of which you would like to place in it. You can purchase items, background and companions from Earthly Goods>Main Stores, Life>Search, Earthly Goods>Auctions, and Help Alacrity>Monthly Shop. The main stores hold backgrounds, accessories, and dyes for your dogs. Using Life>Search and Earthly Goods>Auctions you may find better deals from other users on everything you need for your dog's scene. Lastly, in the Monthly Shop you can find theme items for dog scenes. This will also include companions. On the first of each month new themed items will be released for you to buy for your dog.

Once you have acquired everything for your dog's scene you can go to Earthly Goods>Inventory. You can then select each piece of your scene and choose the dog which you like to place it on.

How do I train my dog? What is TP? Needs to be completed

TP or Total Potential, is the little number listed beside the name on the top of a dog's page. It is

the amount of training the dog will need. The TP listed will not mean anything if the dog is not trained completely in all skills.

To train your dog go to Life>My Kennel and choose the dog you would like to train by clicking its name. You will need to scroll down to the section that reads *Skills*. Below Skills will be a clickable link. All dogs start with a section under Skills that says **Basic Training**: <u>0.00%</u>. You will need to click the link until it reaches 100%. Each time you click to train your dog the amount of energy it has decreases by 5. Once Basic training reaches 100% it will divide into 9 different skills that will also need trained and the skills are: weave pole, teeter totter, chute, tire, A-frame, tunnel, jumps, dog walk and pause table. When the training for this section is complete it becomes a bold number and is no longer clickable. All the skills added together will be around the amount of TP listed at the top of the dog's page.

TP Formula: TP of puppies = stud's total training + bitch's total training; divided by 2; add 5 for every maxed stat from the parents (or add 90 if both parents are maxed).

-Other factors for TP of puppies such as Chances and Breeder Perk can be calculated once the formula total is determined.

How do I breed my dogs?

My dog is injured? How do I make it better?

You must take your dog to the vet, just like in real life. You will need to go to the injured dog's page by clicking its name and scrolling all the way to the bottom. There will be little note about the sickness and/or injury and a button to click to take it to the vet. The prices vary due to some injuries being more severe than others. Along with increased prices, the amount of time for the dog to heal will also be increased. When dogs are injured they are not able to trial
