

Linking your GED.com Account to DAE

GED.com is the site where you will manage all of your GED-related information. This will be the site where you access your practice Ready tests, as well as the site you will log in to in order to take the actual GED test.


To begin, type GED.com into your web Browser (location circled in the image below) then click sign up.




Once you have logged in, click your initials in the upper right hand corner and select edit profile from the drop down menu.



Scroll all the way down to the bottom. Under the heading GED Test Prep Center, click the link edit prep center selection.



On the next page, click "**select**" next to Duluth Adult Education (you can enter 55802 into the search bar if DAE is not visible), then scroll down until you see the "**continue**" button. It is important you find this button, as it is not always visible on the screen without scrolling, and it will not link our accounts if you do not click on "continue."



Linking your account to ours allows us to send you free practice tests, monitor your scores, and provide you with detailed score reports for your studying needs.

You are connected! Let your teacher know that you have linked your account.

GED.com requires each student to pass the GED Ready practice test PRIOR to registering for the actual GED test. Passing is a score of 145 or higher. You must take the official test within 60 days of obtaining the passing Ready test. You can take the Ready test as many times as is needed, but you may need to wait in between taking them.

Earning a free study test is easy!

We like to see 12 hours of study time prior to giving you the free GED Ready test. You can accomplish this in person, through our online GED prep courses, or by completing a paper study packet for each of the four subjects.
