

Elizabeth Ekholm (b. 111954)

After completing her B.Mus. in voice performance, Elizabeth received a Canada Council grant to continue her studies in Europe. She went on to obtain a Ph.D. in vocal / choral pedagogy from McGill University. As well as singing and teaching, Elizabeth has been active as a choral conductor. Co-founding member and former president of the National Association of Teachers of Singing (Montreal Chapter), she has been invited to adjudicate at vocal and choral festivals and to lead workshops in vocal / choral technique. Passionate about early music, she has sung with *Les Voix Médiévales*, under the direction of John Baboukis, and is co-founder of *Amaryllis*, an early music ensemble.
