- Sit next to someone you can copy.
- Read each paragraph carefully and write your own summary or key word in the margin.
- Decide which of the headings in the box exactly matches the main idea of the paragraphs and write the roman numerals in the box.
- Bring some of your grandma's baked goods to bribe the examiner.
- Look at the headings to get a general idea. Don't look too closely since some of them will be incorrect.
- Remember not to just match words in the paragraphs with words in a heading. Think meaning, not words. When you look at the headings, remember that the paragraphs may not contain those exact words.
- Try most of the headings for each paragraph. Mistakes happen because people work too quickly and don't ACTUALLY consider everything carefully.
- Take a dice to the exam and write the numbers that you roll by each letter.
- Focus on the beginning and final sentences since these usually have the most information
- Make sure you underline/circle the words in the text that best match the heading. If you
 do this, you can easily check your answer if you want to use the same heading for
 another paragraph later on.
