



A Vision To Zero Partner Toolkit

About the report

In February, we launched <u>A Vision To Zero</u>, the first-ever trauma-informed roadmap designed to drive meaningful change to end childhood sexual violence (CSV). We now invite your organisation to join the To Zero vision and stand alongside a growing community of stakeholders from across the sector who are helping to turn this roadmap into action.

A Vision To Zero is the result of an 18-month consultative process that brought together over 330 passionate field leaders from more than 50 organizations to develop a unified path toward ending CSV. This field-wide vision was first introduced at the inaugural Global Ministerial Conference on Ending Violence Against Children in Bogotá, Colombia, where it was shared with over 180 participants. Its official launch, in partnership with Safe Futures Hub, engaged 340 community members, reinforcing our collective commitment.

We know that a vision and roadmap alone will not transform the current landscape. Real progress depends on collective action, and the time to act is now. We hope you will join To Zero and our partners in sharing the report with key players who can help us make it a reality.

Messaging guidance

Below are topline messages from the report to use in your communications to supporters and stakeholders who should be a part of our global effort.

The Basics

- To Zero and its partners, including [ORGANIZATION], have built a <u>roadmap for action</u>, fostering collaborative and cross-sector relationships to align our field around a common goal: to end childhood sexual violence.
- To Zero and its partners want to support the people who are already making a difference and inspire advocates, funders, and decision-makers to accelerate the pace of progress.

- Our vision for that future, a future without childhood sexual violence, naturally embraces all
 kinds of broad, positive outcomes. In terms of our immediate focus, it can be summed up in
 six aspects: prevention, healing and justice are rooted in evidence; accountability among
 governments and institutions is robust; digital spaces are safe; political will exists; social
 norms shift; and the field is resourced and united.
- We know that, by working together, we can end childhood sexual violence. And we are determined to make it happen.

Name the Urgency

- Now is the time to change this sense of fatalism, to reject the stigma associated with childhood sexual violence and to come together to build a pathway to the future.
- Ending childhood sexual violence means navigating a complex, global sociopolitical landscape. By focusing on critical areas within our field, we can take targeted, effective action to make our ambition a reality.
- To Zero and its partners have enough evidence of what works to prevent childhood sexual violence. Now, more than ever, our field is ready to align our actions and collaborate to achieve a common aspiration.
- The conversations at the heart of this report have repeatedly highlighted that "the tectonic plates are shifting". Childhood sexual violence, and all forms of violence against children, is now finding its place on the global agenda.
- We must normalize conversations around childhood sexual violence a topic currently hidden by a global culture of silence – including bringing more attention to incest and abuse in the home.
- Join To Zero and be a part of our community of changemakers. Together, we can make our world a safer, more joyful place for children.

Inspire Hope

- Childhood sexual violence is preventable and, by working collectively and by pressurizing and incentivizing others such as government, industry and institutions, we can and will prevent it.
- There are many reasons to feel positive and hopeful about our sector's power to end CSV:
 - o Organizations across our sector want to find ways to expand collaboration.
 - There's increasing awareness of childhood sexual violence across other sectors, such as education and climate, opening avenues for collaboration.
 - We have better evidence on effective interventions to end childhood sexual violence. Our sector has also made great progress in showing how evidence supports real-world actions, using it to galvanize national decision-makers and mobilize donors to support effective work.

- Attention has shifted to focus on the dynamics of scaling up interventions and building research infrastructure to support current and future work in more sustainable ways.
- Having a clear vision allows To Zero to see where seeds and even green shoots of our vision already exist. If we can imagine it we can see it, and if we can see it we can grow it.
- There are significant reasons to be hopeful. There is a growing body of evidence of actions that have had positive results, driven by the courage and determination of the individuals and organizations working tirelessly to create lasting change.
- Ending childhood sexual violence faster is not a simple task, but it is an achievable one.
- Childhood sexual violence is preventable. Working together is the only way to make sure the whole sector is effectively resourced, informed and supported.
