Part 1: "The Hearth and the Salamander" Guy Montag -likes to burn things (pyro) -helmet says "451" - burns down houses that have books, fireman -being followed? Gets a strange feeling while walking home -symbols: salamander, phoenix, 451 -smells like kerosene, he calls it "perfume" -30years old, started being fireman at age 20 Clarisse McClellan (neighbor) -white girl, pale, curious, white dress (white= angel, pure, innocence) -"I'm seventeen and I'm crazy" (5) -has a light in her eyes like a candle -<i>thinks</i> about things, likes to walk around -Clarisse's family sit around and talk= Weird! Guy and Clarisse walk home -Clarisse not afraid of him even tho he's a fireman Against the law to read books!!!!!!!!!!!!!! -Guy says houses have always been fireproof -jet cars: super-fast (get arrested for going 40mph), <u>200ft long billboard</u> -Parlor-walls -Fun parks -Clarisse asks Guy is he happy?

Page 8: -Something hidden in the ventilator grill in his house -he talked to someone else one other time, in a park -only walked together a few minutes but huge impact on him -compares bedroom to a tomb -"ear thimble" "seashells" "wasps"= earbuds for music/radio - Guy is NOT happy was just faking it like wearing a MASK Page 10: -kicks something walking to bed- sleeping pills -Mildred (wife) took all her sleeping pills -Jet bombers going over the house very loud: at war -Guy calls hospital Page 12 -Machine 1: stomach pump -Machine 2: blood transfusion -\$50, not even real doctors, call them handyman/operators, get ten cases a night Page 14 -Guy says there are too many people, all strangers, don't know anyone -Guy wishes he could clean Mildred's mind too -Guy wishes he were at Clarisse's house -Clarisse's uncle says, "everyone using everyone else's coattails" (15)
