#### **UPDATES:**

- Golf Tournament:
  - Holly was unable to attend to share results.
- Boosters Scholarships:
  - Awarded 3 scholarships for \$1250, \$1000 and \$750; Tiered based on previous disbursements and direction of new scholarship committee. Abby Allen, Quin Frawley, Mathew MacDougal were the recipients. Tiered based on the level of involvement of parents within the Boosters program during the athletes school years.
  - Committee looking at establishing these qualifications for the scholarship for the 2025-2026 school year and beyond:
    - Screened for 3 years V jv or team manager role. May need to indicate something for athletes who transfer into the district and may have not been here for the 3 year duration.
    - Coach or AD endorsement
    - 2.3 GPA
    - Confirmation of acceptance into a post graduation program.
    - Applicants who meet the above requirements can then apply and the committee will score applicants based on parent participation in Booster related activities and student's application materials. (60% parent involvement in Boosters, 40% student's application materials)
    - Scoring system set to tier out scholarship award amount.
    - Possible questions in the application to score points could include:
      - Outside of your own sport how do you support other athletics in the district?

- Participation: how many years has a family member participated served on the booster committee with ranges, minimum of 3 meetings each year to meet the requirement (awards most points) (extra points for officers)
- Did you attend or assist with a champions dinner or golf tournament,
- Did you have a family member act as a liaison between the team and booster committee?
- Did a family member of yours volunteer at mHHS sporting events.

Concerns about transition to this new approach and how it will help to pull in more help within boosters at varying levels of need. Discussed consideration for those when we go with this new approach and having parents who have been very involved within Boosters that their student could miss out on a scholarship - known that there will need to be a limit to the amount awarded each year and how many scholarships will be disbursed - Suggested that the amount for the school year that the awards would be disbursed - no final decisions were set at the meeting.

- Bylaws: election of officers brought up in meeting that there are certain systems and procedural safeguards for the committee and what is signed off by officers. Concerns about no notice of public nominations and elections. Challenge with getting officers, and cannot make nominations for this meeting because it was not publicly announced.
  - Concern that Secretary Ruby Allen was at the end of her term and no announcement was made to do a nomination in May and an election in June. (Ruby's term ends the end of the 2025-2026 school year).
- Christy mentioned fall tailgate and how much fun it is for the teams and family members in the past. Was always our first Boosters event, and a Booster's membership push - but all fall teams were involved.
