

What Each Scout Should (and Should Not) Bring to Camp

- **Clothing Items:**
 - Scout Class A Uniform
 - Sweater or light jacket
 - Rain gear or poncho
 - Hat
 - Long pants (required for those scouts taking the swimming merit badge)
 - Under shorts
 - T-Shirts
 - Sturdy closed toed shoes
 - Socks
 - Shoes that can get wet
 - Swim suit and Towel
- **Camping Gear**
 - Sleeping Bag
 - Cot (A cot can be rented for \$7.00, however, they are limited)
 - Flashlight with extra batteries
 - Pocket Knife - not a sheath knife
 - Sunscreen
 - Water Bottle or Canteen
 - Mess Kit and Utensils
 - Insect Repellent
- **Merit Badge Items:**
 - Paper, Pencil or pen
 - Backpack
 - Compass
 - Scout Book
- **Toilet Kits**
 - Toothbrush and Toothpaste
 - Bath Towel and Wash Cloth
 - Extra Toilet Paper
 - Soap and Shampoo
 - Deodorant
 - Comb/Brush
 - Shaving Gear (if needed)
- **Suggested Extras**
 - Sunglasses
 - Camera and Film
 - Travel Alarm
 - Spending Money plus money for craft projects (if required for Merit Badges)
- **Prohibited Items:**
 - Hunting and Sheath Knives
 - Fireworks
 - Firearms/Ammo Candles or any lighting Device with an open flame
 - All electronic devices (i.e. games boys, cell phones, pagers)
 - Skateboards, scooters and bicycles
 - Pets
