Authors are required to follow exactly the manuscript writing guidelines that will be published in the Proceedings of the 1st International Conference on Toward Kalimantan as the New Capital of the Republic of Indonesia. The paper file format is Microsoft Word. Abstract consists of one paragraph in which only words and symbols are allowed. Abstracts may not contain citations of any kind. The abstract contains a brief explanation of the contents of the manuscript such as the method, the results and the conclusion. The Abstract is suggested minimum word count of 200-250 words, meanwhile the number of keywords are 3-5 words. The affiliation of the authors is given at the beginning of the paper with the corresponding author, where the email will be addressed.

## Introduction

This section consists of two paragraphs. The first paragraph contains a literature study related to the contents of the manuscript, explaining what has been researched and reported by others by referring to journals [1], proceedings [2], books [3], chapters of books with multiple authors [4], magazines [5], final assignments [6-8], website [9], Wikipedia [10], archive [11], email [12], discussion [13], decrees [14], newspapers, and others [15].

The second paragraph tells the framework or outline of the manuscript briefly, for example that related to the literature study observations have been made with other ranges of parameters with a modified model. The method of observation will be explained in the Materials and Methods section and the results of the research will be written in the results and discussion.

## Methods

This section can be Models or Experiments. It is also possible for a manuscript to have both Theory and Experiment sections if required. Each new paragraph goes 0.5 cm like this paragraph, while further paragraphs that have tables, equations, and images do not need to use the 0.5 cm indent.

This section can also contain quotations from literature that are considered important to be compared or used in the results and discussion sections, if they cannot be expressed in other forms (equations, figures, tables).

A manuscript may consist of an introduction, theory (and/or experiment, and/or model, and/or method) section, results and discussion, and conclusion. This is followed by the Acknowledgments section (if any) and References.

# **Findings dan Discussion**

This section contains the results obtained using the methods described in the previous section (Theory or and Experiments and or Models). This section can contain tables and figures.

Writing in four pages is more difficult than writing in many pages because the author must choose the effecient word or the important points. In writing the proceedings of this conference, the authors are encouraged to convey interesting things from their research so that the limitations of writing this page can be fulfilled, and other results are sufficiently stated, such as, ".. this research is still being continued to obtain ..", and write down the results in another scientific meeting with reference to previous studies in this manuscript. Thus readers and editors can focus on the main ideas of the authors' manuscripts.

The maximum size of the table is 7 cm wide and 20 cm high and it may not be cut to change pages or replace columns. If you cannot get the table to center alignment, left aligned is allowed. The editor will fix it for you. Table 1 is an example of the table you should use.

Beside the tables, images also often cause problems in displaying them, especially the images in the form of graphics. If there are photos from spectroscopy, SEM, or other results, provide the appropriate resolution so that when the authors set to the maximum size, which is 7 cm wide and 20 cm high, they do not break or become unreadable. The authors are not allowed to insert the scanned photos because it will cause your file size is too large so that it can be a problem in sending it via email. Photos that are predominantly dark in color and only have a little light information, can be inverted to make it easier to print, also include that these results have been inverted. If this is not possible, report that the actual version of the image will be clearer in the online version, such as the sentence "... (see the online version for color images)".

Images that are snapshots from commercial or self-made programs must be clear enough what you want to display, only the layout or the letters must be legible. Adjust to your purpose in displaying the image. Thus the goal is the words contained in the picture.
