

Edge-to-Edge Designs with Rulers

Skill Level: Confident Beginner with some experience with ruler work

Instructor: Jackie

This is a machine quilting class. Jackie will walk you through how to using specific rulers to create edge-to-edge designs on your quilt.

Supply List:

- Machine in working condition and the ability to drop the feed dog
- Ruler foot for your machine
- Slide on table comes with your machine OR a portable table from Sew Steady
- Any brand of sliders to make your table smooth*
- Threads: Top and bobbin threads: Isacord 40wt. polyester, Aurifil 40wt./50wt. cotton*. **Avoid dark color threads.**
- To practice and test the designs, 4 quilt sandwiches, approximately 18" x 22" fat quarter size. **Quilt sandwich is often referred to with a piece of top fabric, batting and backing fabric. Avoid dark color fabrics. Soft color with less busy prints or solid colors are prefer, so you can see your stitches.**
- When you are happy with your test results, you can begin to work on larger quilt sandwiches. Approximately 42" x 36" (a yard of fabric) or a panel fabric, sandwich with backing fabric and batting.
- Participants to choose the rulers that like to work on during class.
 - Sew Steady – Circles on Quilts Set 3 will create a 6" Baptist Fan
 - Amanda Murphy – Baptist Fan will create a 4" fan design
 - Amanda Murphy - Clamshells varies sizes
 - Sewing Steady – DM Quilting Winding Way (like meandering) varies sizes
