

Ice Painting

Prep: Find a tupperware, or anything that you can freeze water in. (A big square is preferable, but experiment with different shapes!) Fill your tupperware with water and freeze.

After the block is frozen, remove from the dish/mold (you might have to run the edges around warm water to remove it) and place it on the ground outside (best if on concrete and not on dirt). Set up paint and paintbrushes next to the ice and let your learner experiment!

*You can also place ice cubes in a plastic bin and let your learner paint on the ice cubes!
