Steps:

- 1. You can search using <u>Michigan eLibrary</u> or <u>Google</u>. Make sure to use Boolean logic when you search.
- 2. Example for Question 1: "Benjamin Franklin" AND "birthplace" search:

 - iv. Clicked on "Search"

ZoteroBib, KnightCite, EasyBib, and MyBib.

You need to check with your teacher to see if you are required to use a specific citation maker. Remember to keep your source open while you create your citation so you don't lose the information.
