Loaner Kayak Procedure at Plymouth Harbor

A family member or a friend of a resident at Plymouth Harbor may use a loaner kayak/s under the following conditions:

- 1. The Plymouth Harbor resident accompanies the friend/family member to the Front Desk in the lobby to sign the appropriate Release of Liability Form.
- 2. The Front Desk Receptionist will need to make a copy of the person/s Driver License of the non-residents taking out the kayak. The Front Desk Receptionist will keep the Driver License until the person borrowing the kayak returns and reports having restored Plymouth Harbor equipment to its assigned place.
- 3. The resident, if able, will accompany their guest/s to select a kayak from the loan racks and obtain Plymouth Harbor paddles and life vest from the outdoor storage chest
- 4. Upon returning from their kayaking adventure, users need to make sure all Plymouth Harbor equipment is rinsed off and cleaned before returning it to its appropriate place.
- 5. Kayakers or the Resident should then Notify the Front desk that they have arrived back safely and returned all Plymouth Harbor equipment. Those who left their licenses at the desk will have them returned in person.
