

## Shot List - Nurse/Staff Interview (Treatment Centers)

### Overview:

Below you will find instructions and a list of questions to ask when conducting an interview with fistula care staff.

### Special Considerations:

- For every person featured in photos and videos there MUST be a [signed release form](#).
- Ensure that people featured in photos are not wearing a mask (As much as is safely possible and still in accordance with local Covid-19 precautions.)
- For all non-English interviews, we will need a sentence-by-sentence translation document.

**Directions:**

- **Sound:** Select a relatively quiet location, and ask the patient to speak up so we can hear them clearly.
- **Location:** Select a location with a colorful background that is not too distracting. Unless it is the only quiet location, do not set up against a blank wall.
- Align the subject within the frame, then begin recording the interview. If you need to move the camera to adjust the shot, let the subject finish speaking first. Do not move the camera while the subject is speaking unless they are completely out of the shot.

**Settings:**

- Please shoot all videos in Full HD (Aspect Ratio: 1920 x 1080)
- FPS: 30 or 60

**Questions:**

1. Please introduce yourself – your name, title and where you work.
2. What are the unique challenges that women in your country face when seeking fistula treatment?
3. What did it feel like the first time you found out about obstetric fistula?
4. What breaks your heart the most about what fistula patients go through?
5. How have you seen fistula surgery improve a woman's life?
6. What will support from donors enable you to do? How is their support meaningful to you?
7. Is there anything else you would like to add about the work you do with fistula patients?
8. Please look at the camera and say "thank you" in your native language. We would like to share this with donors and feature our partners from all around the world.
