Introduction

Hello everyone! Hope the Awake event treated you well. In the *Maple Memo:* New Year Update - January 25, Anna mentions v.220 **Moonlight Magic** that will be released on February 3. My intention is to explain what this event will look like, as this event has already taken place in September of 2020 in KMS.

In summary, this event is much more relaxed than the AWAKE event. As you'll see later in this document, the available amounts of a couple of the items in the Enhance Shop are way less than what AWAKE coin shop had. Makes sense, since this is not a major event (major as in seasonal, just like Rise was for summer and Awake was for winter in GMS). This also means coin capping would be slightly easier and lighter. In addition, this would be a good time to increase your Legion level!

Update: Preview post was posted on 1/27 on the official website, but I think it still doesn't explain the event well enough quite yet. Keep reading to learn more about how the event was like in KMS!

Ellinel Full Moon Party

The event map will look like this. (pretty)



In this event, there will be 3 coin shops. Each coin shop has different coins that they take. In other words, there are 3 coins for you to collect.

3 coins???

In this event, there will be 3 coins for you to collect. Don't get angry just quite yet, as these serve different purposes. Let's see what they look like first.

ok sick sick, but how do we obtain them?

1. Moon Candy

This one is interesting. In the beginning, you would do what you've always been doing - hunting monsters near your level. As you hunt them, you'll receive one coin at a certain rate. As weeks progresses, there will be additional methods of collecting coins. In KMS, the addition went like this:

- 1st week:
 - Hunting monsters near your level (1 coin at a certain rate)
- 2nd week:
 - Obtaining combo kill orbs (1 coin per orb) + week 1 method
- 3rd week:
 - Elite Monster/Champion/Boss elimination (10 coins) + week 1, 2 methods
- 4th week:
 - Using runes (15 coins) + week 1, 2, 3 methods
- 5th week:
 - Helping Pollo and Frito (20 coins) + week 1, 2, 3, 4 methods

This may be confusing a little bit, but all this means is that there will be new methods of obtaining the Moon Candies every week, other than just hunting monsters. You can obtain up to 200 Moon Candies a day per character.

Disclaimer: this is subject to change!!

2. Cotton Candy

You can obtain this from playing mini-games. There were 4 mini-games in total:

- Moon-Star Reverse
 - Matched, first half of the event

You can obtain 100 Cotton Candy a day per character.

Disclaimer: The period of each minigames are subject to change!!

3. Star Candy

Think of the Awake Sage Rock Training Grounds. Bring your strongest character, and beat all the balloons to earn points! Watch the video here.

You can only earn Star Candy after you have capped the Moon Candy limit.

After you collect 2000 Star Candies, you can trade for **ONE** the following growth potions:

- 8 Ellinel Growth Potion 1 (guarantees 1 level up in 200-209 range)
- 4 Ellinel Growth Potion 2 (guarantees 1 level up in 210-219 range)
- 2 Ellinel Growth Potion 3 (guarantees 1 level up in 220-229 range)
- 1 Ellinel Growth Potion 4 (guarantees 1 level up in 230-239 range)

You can only claim the Growth Potion(s) only **ONCE**. Meaning, after you collect 2000 coins and have claimed your potion(s), then you can stop worrying about the Star Bubble Pop to collect Star Candies.

Note: This is subject to change!!!

What does this mean?

Only collect the coins you need! If you need event rings/reinforcement items/growth items, collect the Moon Candies. If you only want the decoration/mounts/damage skin, only collect the Cotton Candies.

This separation is to prevent bots from minigames. If bots play minigames in this event, all they're doing is making their characters pretty. In KMS there has been cases where botters participate and coin cap through minigames and buy all the reinforcement/growth items. This won't prevent the botters completely, but this is what they'll do for future events (the most recent NEO patch already uses this format).

Coin Shop!

Now that we know how to get each coin, let's see how we can spend them.

1. Moonlight Enhancement Shop - uses MOON CANDIES

2. Magic Wand - uses Moon Candies

Remember the Dok & Kaebi's Magic Batons from Goblin Full Moon Night Market a while back? Or have you used/seen an Extreme Growth Potion (potion that gives 1 - 10 levels at random to a character between level 141 - 199)? This is what that is.

Usage is limited as following:

- Weekdays once per world
- Weekends (Sat., Sun.) twice per world
- Korean Thanksgiving Day 3 times per world
 - I assume they'll either take this out or change it.

On 1/27, a new post on Maplestory website named <u>Moonlight Magic Event Preview</u> was posted. In that post it says...

"A swish of Phiny's Magic Wand is all it takes to gain extra levels! In exchange for your Moon Candy, Phiny will use his magic wand and level your character at random, up to 10 levels. The lower your character level, the higher your probability to gain more levels at once. Remember, the magic wand only works for characters with levels between Lv. 141 and Lv. 199!"


Note: "In exchange for your Moon Candy" means it will cost 200 Moon Candy, the daily limit.

3. Cotton Candy Workshop - uses *Cotton Candy*This shop only sells <u>decoration items!!!</u>
Update: From watching the livestream, these items will be in the next patch!!!
