Sales are going well. Wednesdays sales alone were at \$1,200.00. Apparel has brought in over \$11,000.00 but still in need of additional funds . These would be for additional apparel items and for storage. The health department has informed us that we cannot leave the boxes stacked in the Parent Room on the floor. We are asking for another \$10,000.00. Andrea Vaughn states that the budget is tight and would prefer to do a smaller amount up front. New proposal was made to give \$7,500.00 upfront. This would be for \$5,000.00 towards apparell orders and \$2,500.00 for a locked storage cabinet with wheels. The motion for this was made and approved.

We had over 97 pay, contributed the last 3 paid amounts so that we were able to say that we had 100 people pay at the door and we were rewarded \$250.00. Our first Chilis Night raised \$90.00. The restaurant acknowledge that this was poorly planned last time and has promised to be better prepared for the next Chilis night. Attractions Books are still coming in. We are 93 books short. We should have a \$5,000.00 profit. Innisbrook totals are coming in and it looks like we will have an \$8,000.00 profit. We are also proposing another fundraiser with Otis Spunkmeyer Cookies. This will start on 10/31/13 and the deadline will be 11/15/13. The orders will go in by Thanksgiving and we will have a delivery date of 12/12/13. We will receive a \$6.40/tub profit. Delivery will come in at 1pm. Parents will be notified the day before pick-up. If a parent is not there by 5:30 they will be contacted about pick-up. The company will be happy to take home orders that are not picked up if there is a storage issue. Online ordering is not available for this fundraiser. A motion was made for this fundraiser to be presented to the office and approved. Jillian has also approved a Snowflake Shop. This will be incorporated into Character Ed. Children will be allowed to

bring a small amount of money and make gift purchases.

Everyone will receive \$1.00 in Snowflake cash so that they will all have the opportunity to buy at least one thing. The store dates are 12/3-12/6. Jennifer Augustine tells Jillian that this is fine to present to the Character Ed Committee at their next meeting. The last two items is that Sharkey Haircuts will give \$3.00 for cuts done in November. Info about this will go home soon. Lastly, Jillian will contact The Icehouse about an Ice Skating Skate Night.
