	Life Story (Timeline)	<p>Colton: Lucille Ball was born on August 6, 1911. She was born in Jamestown, New York. Her parents' names were Henry Ball and Desiree Ball. She had a sibling whose name was Fred Ball. She grew up in Celoron, New York. Her family had trouble making money as a child.</p> <p>Brylee: Lucille Ball went to high school at Southwestern Central school and after high school she went to college at Dramatic Arts in New York City. She got kicked out of college because she didn't have any talent at first. They said she was not talented enough. She stopped going to high school at the age of 15.</p> <p>Katie: She married Desi Arnaz in 1940 and had 2 children - Lucie and Desi Jr. They divorced 20 years later in 1960. She then married Gary Morton. She was 6 years older than Gary when they got married. She started a show that was called <i>I Love Lucy</i>. It was a 35 min show in a studio audience. It was a 50 greatest TV show of all time. They ended the show in 1957 and had 181 episodes. Fun fact, she was pregnant during the show but still continued to do her acting job! Lucille Ball's favorite episode was <i>Lucille's Italian movie</i>. She made \$4,000 per episode!!</p> <p>Nova: She became a comedy actress and past away on April 26, 1989 from a heart disease. She died at 5:47 a.m at the age 77 and if she was alive, she would be 112 years old. Her last words before she passed away were "I</p>
