Directors Report:

President: VACANT

VP Admin: Jaycee Frost

-Gave a brief update on the teams who travelled out of town this past weekend.

-Purchased the hockey cards for the OCN kid who lost his collection due to bullying with the money that was raised by players of TMHA. Going to put it in a nice gift basket to present. U13 A Team will take it down to The Pas when they travel.

Jaycee introduced Damon Werrell to the board.

VP Technical: Damon Werrell

- One incident came about, dealt with it informally – submitted report to Jaycee.
- Nothing to report.

Officials Coordinator: Sean Weatherill

- Few setbacks
- Not much help from previous Officials Coordinator
- No access to the software
- Rough list of officials, needs more information
- Few questions about safety policies
- Experienced a few mishaps this week with scheduling
- Need more consistency of what kind of Hockey the Official will be reffing prior to the start of the game (3 on 3, 4 on 4, 5 on 5 full contact, etc.)
- Need to find a system going to get Officials program running smoothly
- U18 neck guards, some are altered, some are not wearing them at all... going to start giving penalties

Serge Default: The minute you penalize a player for the neck guards, the rest will follow suit.

- ☐ Going to send email out to coaches about neck guards.

- Coaches need to help address the neck guard issue
- STOP Sign policy, NO stop signs on the U15-U18 jerseys
- If were having checking in the U15-U18 division, need to have the STOP sign, huge liability if someone gets checked from behind
- Takes the liability off the board if we make this investment
- Would like to have officials start at U13

2. NEW BUSINESS

● U18 Budget Approval

MOTION: Approve the U18 budget.

Martin Murphy: Would like to have toques made by an out of town vendor – local vendors had a turn-around-time of 3.5 months

- **Complaints**

Damon Werrell:

- Need to be united as a board on how we deal with complaints.
- Complaints need to come to the president in a written format to be properly addressed by the TMHA Board

- **Tournament Planning**

- A few members willing to help Judd with the tournaments (Cheryl Crawley & Jenny Cameron)
- Board gave Judd direction who to contact regarding tournament leads in each division

- **Discipline/ Appeals Committee – PROCESS**

Damon Werrell:

- Written complaint received by President > Brings complaint to Board > Board will review and decides how to deal with complaint. Either informally, or will to disciplinary committee
- Complaints will be vetted by Damon if need be

- **Officials Payment – Game Cancellations/ Officiating alone**

Sean Weatherill:

- Current policy states its prohibited for Officials to Ref alone (Hockey Canada/ Hockey MB), wants 2 official system minimum. If they Ref alone, they are typically not allowed to receive more than the normal rate.
- Unique situation with not enough refs in the North
- Would like to move away from paying double, having 2 Officials minimum at all games
- If an official arrives at a game and the game was cancelled/ turned into a practice, they should be compensated
- Need a new structured system for tracking Officials Scheduled games, cannot rely on game sheets
- Google Docs spreadsheet: FREE! Would be accessible for the board, directors, and Officials
 - ☐ Sean going to create a document for next meeting. Directors need to send in December schedules.
- Officials to be paid bi-weekly by cheque

- **Board Expectations on contact – U13**

- Coaches saying little bit of contact is OK....
- Coaches need to reiterate NO CONTACT in divisions below U15
- Each REP team should have a designated safety person, not just the coaches. Need the CAT Training to be properly certified (as per *Hockey Manitoba*). Concussion clinic available online.
 - ☐ Directors to send email out to Coaches to remind players of safe contact
 - ☐ Damon to draft letter to coaches, Refs, & parents RE: CONTACT on the Ice
 - ☐ Jaycee will reach out to Greg Long to recommendations
