Any book of your choosing. Some suggestions are listed in <u>the PA Reader's Choice Award Nominees selected</u> by the Pennsylvania School Library Association


Grading:

- B. Students will complete a **Flip Grid book talk** in class during the first week of school for their **self-selected choice book**.
