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Abstract: These guidelines are provided to make it easy to read with a consistent format. Please complete your extended abstract paper in strict conformance with these guidelines. The extended abstract paper has to be submitted electronically by e-mail to the following addresses: simpora17@gmail.com or to the link provided no later than **31st July 2026**. Please write a concise abstract limited to **200 words only** which presents in short the content and, very importantly, the review and results of the paper in English. The font and size should be **Calibri 10pt**, except the paper title, which should be 18pt. All text is to be single-spaced and left and right justified typesetting. Do not set page numbers and the header of the paper. All papers should be submitted in Word .doc or .docx format. Full paper is required to prepare a **minimum of eight (8)** and a **maximum of ten (10) pages**. The Conference proceedings will be published with an eISSN number and in an electronic format. The **theme** of conference proceedings is **Malay Ethos in contemporary World: Design, Environment and Humanities**, which sufficient to the following areas: (1) Design & Built Resilient (2) Cultural-Tradition Resilient (3) Socio-demography Resilient (4) Technology, and (5) Environmental Resilient.

INTRODUCTION

It is expected that authors will submit **carefully written** and **proofread material**. Spelling and grammatical errors, as well as language usage problems, are not acceptable in the final submission. Papers should clearly describe the background of the subject, the author's work, including the methods related, and a concluding discussion on the importance of the work. Papers are to be **prepared in English** (British or American) only. Technical terms should be

explained. Acronyms should be written out at their first appearance such as Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM).

1.1 Sheets for Papers and Typing

Prepare the **camera-ready manuscripts on A4** paper sheet size 297 mm x 210 mm (11.69 x 8.27 inches). Set upper, lower, left, and right margins to 25.4mm (1 inch). The entire text is to be typed in a single wide column across the whole page.

1.2 Length. Figure and Table

Type subheadings flush with the left margin, in bold upper case and lower-case letters (Title Case). All manuscripts are limited to **ten (10) single-spaced pages**, including the Title block, abstract, figures, tables, and references. Additional pages are not accepted. Figure captions and table headings should be sufficient to explain the figure or table without needing to refer to the text. Styles Heading Table and Caption Figure are available in this template for tables and figures. Tables and figures should be placed close after their first reference in the text. All figures and tables should be numbered. Table headings should be above the tables. Figure captions should be centered below the figures. Minimum **figures and image resolution: 150dpi**. Figures and tables are to be numbered in their respective order, e.g. Figure 1, Table 1, Figure 2, Figure 3, Table 2, etc.
