## UIP

- PPEC SPF
  - We are at 84%
  - Goal is to get to 90%
- Unified Improvement Plan

- Three indicators
  - Participation
    - Testing accountability is more impactful
  - Academic Achievement
    - Our students rank, on average, in the top 4% for reading and English.
    - Our students 87% percentile in math
    - An area of growth is in SAT Math - if we get from 511.7 to 530, we can get to Exceeds
  - Academic Growth
  - Postsecondary & Workforce Readiness
    - Matriculation dropped 10% to 66%
    - Four-year college doubled to 48%
- DPF - District Performance Framework
  - The district is at 49.7
- Major Improvement Strategies
  - #1: Continued Emphasis on a Culture of Academics
    - 75% or higher of students will score at or above the state proficiency benchmark on STAR Reading & Math assessment by the end of 24-25 AY
      - PSAT/SAT prep options on Fridays
      - PackBack Writing Lab - we are piloting at the high school level
      - WAC
  - #2: PPEC will see an 80% or higher participation in the District Culture and Climate Survey. At least 65% of students will respond favorably to the following questions: "The adults at my school really care about me." "Teachers at my school make the class a safe space to share ideas and participate.", "I have at least one adult who I can talk to at school."
  - #3 Increased Growth on Star 360 Reading and Math Assessments
    - At least 50% of students will meet or exceed the national percentile for typical growth on the STAR 360 Math and Reading Assessments by the end of the 2024-2025 school year
      - Additional support on Friday with Mr. Beadles
      - Hiring a .32 math Geometry support teacher
      - Implementation of regular PLC meetings on Friday afternoons
      - Implementation of PackBack, Quizziz, IXL, Khan Academy
  - #4 Continued Focus on College, Career Readiness, and WBL
    - PPEC had a 6% overall drop in 2023 - will be recovered to 95%
      - We are already at 93.8%
    - Focus on matriculation rates

## Data used

- STAR 360 BOY Math and Reading
  - Reminder that just because a student is college ready doesn't always mean that they are test ready
  - Math
    - 9th, 74% met or exceeded expectations
    - 10th, 60% met or exceeded expectations
    - 11th, 82% met or exceeded expectations
  - Reading
    - 9th - 86% met or exceeded expectations
    - 10th - 86% met or exceeded expectations
    - 11th - 92% met or exceeded expectations
  - All PPEC students in 9th-11th grade are expected to test this year regardless of college course status.
- Writing Across the Curriculum Data
  - 2nd year of implementation of WAC pilot
  - Have calibrated the scoring between teachers
  - 9th-
  - BOY, MOY, and EOY will have different focuses
  - The lowest score area was in citations and references
    - Students' strongest areas:
      - Thesis, evidence and support, counterargument, organization, clarity & style, grammar & mechanics,
    - Areas of needed improvement:
      - Introduction, conclusion, citations
