## How have you been using the Picoh? - BV

So we're using the Picohs with Chromebooks. So all the students have their own Chromebooks and we've got 15 Picohs, so they have one between two at. They plug in the Picoh with a lead to the Chromebooks.

And there's a little bit of technical setup that you have to do once at the beginning, which is very clearly laid out on the Picoh website.

As a Google admin, I could push out the extension to all of them beforehand. So that was done. They didn't need to do that.

And then there was another step where they had to enable the flag and restart their device .After that, from then on, they just plugged it in and it worked. Then they just go to the Scratch.Co.uk website and it just looks like scratch is at normal scratch interface, but with the addition of some Picoh blocks at the bottom.

And so the students were used to it, they recognised it. They knew how to interact with at, and they could just add in and explore the new blocks and see how it affected the Picoh device.
