Društvo SMC Maribor was founded in 1998 as a non-profit NGO with the mission to provide support to the youngsters and to promote active citizenship, responsibility, and voluntarism, and to contribute to personal growth of young and their families. Centre primarily works in the local and regional area and it has become one of the best non-governmental youth centers in the region.

Our focus group is teenagers and our doors are open to them every day of the week. We provide tutorial help, consultations for them and their parents and other assistance they may need growing up. A lot of them join us as volunteers working with younger generation of children.

We also provide trainings and non-formal learning opportunities at really low or no costs at all. In recent years we participated in several international youth exchange projects and our focus is to extend our work in that area to ensure even more possibilities for local youth and to enable international learning experiences to our youngsters.

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The hosting organization (Društvo SMC Maribor) will cover: accommodation, food, transportation, (to the limit amount given by Erasmus +), activities and programme expenses.

AIM: **Active Youth = EU Future** exchange aims at empowering young people to discover and develop their true potential, to acquire skills for healthy growing up and to enhance self-empowerment and self-esteem in Intercultural Learning setting.

MAIN GOALS: building self confidence and independence, respect for themselves and others, experiencing the need for teamwork and accepting differences, developing problem solving and leadership skills, taking responsibility for their own actions and decisions, developing social and life skills, experiencing healthy living, understanding the needs and backgrounds of others, developing a sense of community and active citizenship, developing a sense of equality and fairness, promoting an awarness and respect for the enviornment, promoting importance of lifelong learning, improved foreign languages competence having in mind the broad European linguistic diversity, gaining information about existing possibilities and conditions for the development of European youth co-operation projects among EU and neighbouring countries, with special focus on the Erasmus+ Program, developing an informal network of young people coming from neighbouring countries.

DURATION: 8 days (including travelling days) youth exchange in a period of August 30th (arrival day) – September 6th (departure day), 2020.

PARTICIPANTS: Young people aged between 18 and 30, coming from Slovenia, Hungary, Slovakia, Italy, Portugal, Republic of North Macedonia, Latvia, UK, Greece and Romania => 54 (4 young person + 1 youth leader per country + 4 extra youth workers/leaders as support staff on Slovenian team).

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER
