Our extension's single purpose is to provide you with notifications and quick actions for your Yahoo Mail account. We are committed to collecting only the minimum amount of information necessary to provide this service.

1. Information We Collect and Why

To function, our extension needs to handle certain types of information. All of this data is handled locally on your computer or directly between your browser and Yahoo's servers.

A. Email Metadata

What we collect: When a new email arrives, we access its metadata, which includes the sender's name/email address, the subject line, and a short snippet of the email body. Why we collect it: This information is essential to display a meaningful notification to you, allowing you to quickly see who an email is from and what it's about. This data is used only for display purposes within the notification and the extension's popup.

B. Authentication Tokens

What we collect: After you log in to your Yahoo account through the official Yahoo authentication screen, we securely store an OAuth token provided by Yahoo. Why we collect it: This token is a secure key that allows our extension to make authorized requests to the Yahoo Mail API on your behalf. It is necessary to check for new emails and perform actions like "Mark as Read" or "Reply" without requiring you to enter your password repeatedly. This token is stored securely using the chrome.storage.local API on your computer.

C. User-Configured Settings

What we collect: We store your preferences for the extension, such as your chosen theme (light/dark) or notification settings.

Why we collect it: This is necessary to provide a personalized experience that is saved every time you use your browser. These settings are stored using the chrome.storage.sync API, which syncs them across your devices where you are logged into your Chrome profile.

2. Information We DO NOT Collect

We believe in privacy by design. To be perfectly clear, we DO NOT:

Store the content of your emails on our servers. All email content is fetched from Yahoo's servers and displayed directly to you in the extension. It is never transmitted to or stored by us.

Track your browsing history or your activity on any website other than Yahoo Mail. Our content scripts and host permissions are strictly limited to the Yahoo Mail domain to provide real-time notifications.

Sell, rent, or share any of your personal information with any third parties for marketing or any other purpose.

Collect any analytics or anonymous usage statistics. We do not track how you use the extension.

3. Data Storage and Security

Local Storage: All sensitive information, including your authentication token and settings, is stored locally on your computer using the standard, secure chrome.storage API.

Secure Communication: All communication between the extension and Yahoo Mail's servers is encrypted and transmitted securely over HTTPS.

Limited Permissions: We only request the minimum permissions necessary for the extension to function as described. Each permission has been carefully considered and is justified in our store listing.

4. Third-Party Services
