San Jacinto College Dual Credit Grade Reporting Fall 2023 and beyond

Beginning in the fall 2023 semester, San Jacinto College will no longer report numerical grades to Pasadena ISD and will report letter grades only for all students enrolled.

This change will affect all courses taken for dual credit via College Now or Early College High School. This will not affect any high school courses.

Changes to Pasadena ISD Dual Credit GPA based on San Jacinto College Grading System

In partnership with San Jacinto College, Pasadena ISD is proud to offer students the opportunity to enroll in college courses through our College Now Dual Credit and Early College High School programs. Many of these courses are available at reduced cost (College Now) or no cost (Early College High School) to students in grades 9-12. Beginning in the 2023-24 school year, in alignment with state standards, San Jacinto College will no longer issue numerical grades for students and will only issue letter grades of A, B, C, D, F, or F/X. All letter grades from college classes will now be converted using the chart below for input on the high school transcript and awarding grade points. Dual credit courses will be reflected as either Honors Level or Advanced Level for GPA purposes.
